The mission of the ABPath is to promote the health of the public and advance the practice and science of pathology by establishing voluntary certification standards and assessing the qualifications of those seeking to practice the specialty of pathology.

Active in academia, Dr. Agarwal-Antal serves as a full Clinical Professor within the Department of Pathology and Clinical Associate Professor within Internal Medicine at Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED).
