Subsequently, Dr. Lawyer received her medical degree from The Ohio State University, and completed her residency in orthopedic surgery at the University of Mississippi Medical Center. In addition to her medical degree, she also earned a Doctor of Philosophy degree (Ph.D.) focusing on cartilage regeneration. She completed a fellowship in sports medicine at the University of Pittsburgh where she worked with leaders and innovators in sports medicine, Dr. Freddie Fu and Dr. James Bradley. During her fellowship, she worked with the Pittsburgh Steelers and Pittsburgh Penguins.

As a testament to her continued education, she is board-certified in orthopedic surgery and sports medicine by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery (ABOS). The ABOS is an organization with the goal of establishing educational and professional standards for orthopedic residents and surgeons as well as evaluating the qualifications and competence of orthopedic surgeons.

In addition to seeing patients at St. Luke's Clinic - Orthopedics, Dr. Lawyer is the team physician for the Rocky Mountain High School Grizzlies and Boise Hawks. She has authored multiple peer-reviewed research articles and has presented her work at national meetings.
