At the CHWC Urology Clinic at Bryan Hospital, comprehensive, patient-centered care is available to individuals seeking help for acute conditions such as urinary tract infections (UTIs), kidney and bladder stones, overactive bladder, incontinence, pelvic floor dysfunction, hematuria (blood in the urine), cancers of the bladder and kidney, neurogenic bladder, fistula, and many others.

The urology team at CHWC provides gender-specific care for men and women as well. Urogynecology specialty care is available to female patients with pelvic organ prolapse and mesh problems, female stress incontinence, and female sexual dysfunction. Our team also treats a range of male-specific issues, including prostate problems, infertility, erectile dysfunction, cancers of the prostate and testicles, penile conditions, and more.
