Maintaining fellowship status, Dr. Bedolla is a Fellow of the American College of Emergency Physicians (FACEP), and a Fellow of the Texas Leadership and Advocacy Program of the Texas College of Emergency Physicians (FTCEP).

On a professional level, he is an active member of the Society for Academic Emergency Medicine, the Society for Medical Decision Making, the American Stroke Society, the American Society for Healthcare Risk Management, and the International Council of Motorsports Sciences.

Throughout his illustrious career, Dr. Bedolla has served in many leadership roles including as Medical Student Clerkship Director, Hospital Chief of Staff, Morbidity and Mortality Director, Peer Review Director, and Physician Liaison for a state medical board.
