
## **Karim El-Sherief, MD, FACC, an Interventional Cardiologist** with Tri-City Medical Center

The field includes medical diagnosis and treatment of congenital heart defects, coronary artery disease, heart failure, valvular heart disease, and electrophysiology. Cardiologists are doctors who diagnose, assess, and treat patients with diseases and defects of the heart and blood vessels (the cardiovascular system).

Throughout his illustrious career, Dr. El-Sherief has been the recipient of various honors and accolades, including the Patients' Choice Award (2018, 2009, 2008), and the On-Time Doctor Award (2018).
