In 2007, Dr. Patel began his residency training in anesthesiology at the Saint Barnabas Medical Center in Livingston, New Jersey. He served as Chief Resident in Anesthesiology during his final year.

Upon completion of his residency training, Dr. Patel began his fellowship training in pain medicine at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine. During his time there, he was fortunate to learn from a diverse group of leading physicians in the field of pain medicine, as well as from leaders in hospice care, neurology, psychiatry, and physical medicine & rehabilitation. While at Mount Sinai, Dr. Patel was trained in many of the most innovative and advanced therapies established in the field of pain medicine.

After finishing his fellowship training, Dr. Patel began working as an anesthesiologist at the Mount Sinai Brooklyn Hospital in Midwood Brooklyn. There, he worked closely with surgeons specializing in general, thoracic, spine, and orthopedic surgery. He developed protocols for acute postoperative pain management for both ambulatory and inpatient procedures. He also offered specialized therapies for acute postoperative pain management through the use of ultrasound-guided regional anesthesia.

Pain management, pain medicine, pain control, or algiatry, is a branch of medicine employing an interdisciplinary approach for easing the suffering and improving the quality of life of those living with chronic pain. As an anesthesiologist & interventional pain management specialist, Dr. Patel's special interests include fluoroscopically guided minimally invasive procedures, neurostimulation, ultrasound-guided therapies, peripheral joint injections, as well as platelet-rich plasma and stem cell therapies.
