Cleaning up the bad areas

Kevin buys the property occupied by drug addicts, gets them out with the help of police, cleans the bad areas, rehabs the buildings, and cleans up the city. His vision is to make this city a safer place to live.

Placing tenants coming from Section 8 programs or similar

Kevin works in coordination with community groups to place tenants in the properties that are coming from section 8 programs or similar. The Section 8 program was created by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1978. It provides assistance to eligible low- and moderate-income families to rent housing in the private market. It is also called the Housing Choice Voucher program.

Working with the city police to create crime-free certified communities

Kevin works with the local police to visit the areas that usually most property developers are not willing to go to. **Kevin Easterly** also mentioned once, "We also put on events with police to come to our properties and share good times with the children."
