The mission of the ABPS is to promote safe, ethical, and efficacious plastic surgery to the public by maintaining high standards for the education, examination, certification, and continuous certification of plastic surgeons as specialists and subspecialists.

On a professional level, he is an active member of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, the American Society for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery, the Robert H. Ivy Pennsylvania Plastic Surgery Society (Executive Board Member), the Berks County Medical Society (Executive Committee Member), American Medical Association, and the Pennsylvania Medical Society.

With a passion for teaching, Dr. Schlechter has served as a Clinical Instructor for the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine Plastic Surgery Fellowship since 2010.
