The ABS is an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.

General surgery is a surgical specialty that focuses on abdominal contents including the esophagus, stomach, small bowel, colon, liver, pancreas, gallbladder, appendix, and other body systems. A general surgeon performs a wide range of surgeries for many forms of intestinal and abdominal wall neoplasms, gallbladder disease, and gastric and biliary disease. They follow the patient through critical care and surgical recovery to outpatient care.
