
Jeanne H. Cleveland, MD, a Cardiothoracic Surgeon with Mercy Clinic Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery

After earning her medical degree from the Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine in Chicago, Dr. Cleveland went on to complete her residency in thoracic and cardiovascular surgery at the University of Utah Medical Center, followed by her fellowship in thoracic and cardiovascular surgery at the University of Utah Hospital.

Cardiothoracic surgery (also known as thoracic surgery) is the field of medicine involved in the surgical treatment of organs inside the thorax (the chest). Cardiothoracic surgeons, like Dr. Cleveland, are medical doctors who specialize in surgical procedures inside the thorax (the chest), which may involve the heart, lungs, esophagus, and other organs in the chest. Alongside performing surgery, they also diagnose and treat diseases of these organs.
