Her clinical interests include valvular heart disease, cardiac imaging, and congestive heart failure.

at Long Island Jewish Forest Hills Hospital, where she also served as Chief Resident. Finally, she completed her fellowship in general cardiology at Mount Sinai Medical Center.

As a testament to her continued education, the doctor is board-certified in cardiovascular disease, echocardiography, nuclear cardiology, and internal medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

On a professional level, she is an active member of the American College of Cardiology and the American Society of Echocardiography. She has authored several peer-reviewed publications on the topics of pulmonary arterial hypertension, rare cardiomyopathies, and valvular disorders. She has also presented her research work at national and international conferences.

Cardiology is a branch of medicine that deals with the disorders of the heart, as well as some parts of the circulatory system. The field includes medical diagnosis and treatment of congenital heart defects, coronary artery disease, heart failure, valvular heart disease, and electrophysiology. Cardiologists are doctors who diagnose, assess, and treat patients with diseases and defects of the heart and blood vessels (the cardiovascular system).

Speaking multiple languages, Dr. Guigui is fluent in English, French, and Hebrew, and proficient in Spanish.
