Later, he completed his fellowship in hematology & medical oncology at the Baylor College of Medicine in 1990.

As a testament to his success, the doctor is board-certified in medical oncology, hematology, and

internal medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). Dr. Lasker served as president and manager of The Baptist Physician Alliance (BPA) from 2009-2019. BPA is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Professionally, Dr. Lasker is an active member of the Medical Association of Alabama, the Jefferson County Medical Society, and the American Society of Clinical Oncology.

Hematology is the branch of medicine concerned with the study of the cause, prognosis, treatment, and prevention of diseases related to blood. Oncology is a branch of medicine that deals with the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of cancer. A hematologist-oncologist is a physician who specializes in the diagnosis, treatment, or prevention of cancer, malignant blood diseases such as leukemia, lymphoma, and multiple myeloma, and blood disorders such as iron-deficiency anemia, clotting abnormalities, hemophilia, and sickle-cell disease.
