

Know How To Apply For Skilled Worker Visa UK And More

Do you want to work and live in the UK? It's not just you. Every year, an increasing number of people apply to work in the UK. But you will require a visa if you intend to relocate to the UK. The skilled worker visa is one of many accessible visas.

To be qualified, applicants must receive at least 70 points under the points-based system. Read this article to know more about the requirements and more things about the visa.

What is the UK Skilled Worker Visa?

International workers with the required abilities can work in the UK for authorized UK employers thanks to the UK Skilled Worker Visa. At the end of 2020, the Tier 2 (General) visa was replaced by the **skilled worker visa uk**. Now, persons with skills in an appropriate occupation at RQF Level 3 (equal to an A-level in the UK) or higher are eligible for the program.

The initial period of the UK Skilled Worker Visa, which can be obtained for up to five years, is long-term (this will depend on the duration of your Certificate of Sponsorship). It's crucial to remember that your visa is only good for as long as you continue to work for your sponsoring employer in the same capacity. You must submit a new Skilled Worker visa application if you want to switch jobs or employers.

The skilled worker option allows you to extend your visa before it expires and then apply for indefinite

permission to remain (ILR) and British residence one year later after meeting the requirements for five years. If you're thinking about applying for a **skilled worker visa uk**, make sure you have a job offer in place and that you match the requirements listed below.

How to qualify for the Skilled Worker Visa

A certificate of sponsorship is required for applicants to be eligible for the skilled worker visa. The certification needs to be issued by a recognized UK employer. A Sponsor is another name for a recognized UK employer.

The position being offered must be one of the professions that qualify. A minimum wage must be paid to the employee. The type of employment they undertake will determine the minimum wage.

The individual employment offer will determine each case's exact eligibility. Therefore, we strongly advise applicants to consult a skilled consultant.

Knowledge of English

All applicants for a **skilled worker visa uk** must meet the English language requirement. If you had completed this in a prior application, you will be excluded.

The following options exist for satisfying the English Language Requirement:

- You are a citizen of a nation where English is the primary language.
- possess a GCSE, A level, Scottish Higher or Advanced Higher in English, or a Scottish National Qualification at level 4 or 5.
- possess a degree-level academic credential from an English-taught or English-researched program. You must validate your study abroad status with UK NARIC.
- You successfully completed a Secure English Language Test (SELT) from a recognized tester.

Candidates who are sponsored to practice as doctors, dentists, nurses, or midwives and who have already successfully completed an English Language Assessment by the appropriate regulated professional body are exempt from providing proof of their English skills. You must know this while applying for a **skilled worker visa uk**.

Salary requirements

Typically, you'll need to earn at least £25,600 annually. You must, however, make at least that amount if the "going rate" for your line of work is higher.

There are certain exclusions, though. If your employment qualifies but your pay is below the minimum wage or the going rate, you can still be qualified. If your pay is at least £20,480 per year and is between 70% and 90% of the market rate for your profession, you can be eligible for a **skilled worker visa uk** if you also meet the following criteria:

- The position is listed as a shortage occupation.
- You are a student, recent graduate, professional in training, or under the age of 26.
- You hold a Ph.D. in a field related to your line of work, which could be in science, technology, engineering, or math (STEM).
- Your income must be at least £23,040 per year if you have a Ph.D. in another field.

- You work as a postdoctoral researcher in academia or science.

What Are The Required Documents?

As part of the application procedure, you will have to provide the Home Office with specific information and supporting documentation for your **skilled worker visa uk**.

You will have to submit the following documentation:

- A current passport or other proof of identity and nationality
- The reference number on your certificate of sponsorship
- Evidence of your English language proficiency (unless exempt)
- Your name, occupation, and annual salary
- The business's name and sponsorship license number

Additionally, you might be requested to give the following details:

- Bank statements proving your ability to sustain yourself, as described below
- If your partner, kids, or other dependents are applying with you, you must provide proof of your relationship with them.
- Test results for tuberculosis (if applicable)
- For certain jobs, a criminal background check certificate is required. (Generally speaking, these are positions in the welfare, hospital, and educational sectors.
- Your UK Ph.D. certificate or special UK NARIC reference number if your degree was earned elsewhere (if applicable)

Any paperwork that isn't in English or Welsh needs to be translated by a qualified translator. In your portfolio of proof, you must include both the original version and the translated version.

How Much is a Skilled Worker Visa UK?

Depending on your situation, the cost of a **skilled worker visa uk** application might range from £610 to \$1,408.

You should also factor in the following costs while requesting your visa:

The annual healthcare surcharge is £624.

When you arrive in the UK, you must be able to show that you can sustain yourself by having at least £1,270 available. If you have been in the UK for at least 12 months on a valid visa or if your employer will pay your expenses for the first month of your stay, you may be excluded from this requirement.

How Long Does a Skilled Worker Visa UK Application Take?

Up to three months before the day you are scheduled to begin employment in the UK, you may submit your visa application. Your sponsorship certificate should include this date.

The Home Office may require additional time to check your documents and verify your identity depending on your specific situation. You should always allocate additional time and submit your application on time because of this. If you are outside of the UK, the **skilled worker visa uk** typically

takes 3 weeks to hear from the Home Office. You might have to wait up to 8 weeks if you already reside in this nation.
