Recognized as a Fellow of the American Academy of Dermatology (FAAD), the doctor is board-certified in dermatology by the American Board of Dermatology (ABD). The ABD is a voluntary, non-profit, private, autonomous organization formed for the primary purpose of protecting the public interest by establishing and maintaining high standards of training, education, and qualifications for physicians rendering care in dermatology.

A 16-year veteran of the United States Air Force, Dr. Freeland has deployed 10 times in the service of our great country. He spent several tours in the Middle East, including multiple deployments to Afghanistan and Iraq.

Most recently, he served on the teaching faculty at the dermatology residency program at Walter Reed Medical Center and carried an academic appointment at the military medical school in Bethesda, Maryland.
