
## Luis R. Munoz, MD, a Pediatrician with The Hospitals of Providence Children's Hospital

Holding an academic rank, he currently serves as a Clinical Professor of Pediatrics at Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center El Paso.

Pediatrics is the branch of medicine that involves the medical care of infants, children, and adolescents. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends individuals be under pediatric care up to the age of 21. Pediatricians provide medical care to people ranging in age from newborns to young adults. They are trained to examine, diagnose, and treat children with a wide variety of injuries and illnesses through all of their developmental stages, as they grow and mature.

Successful in his field, Dr. Munoz has been the recipient of many awards and honors throughout his career, including Patients' Choice Award (2018, 2017, 2016, 2015, 2014, 2012, 2011, 2010, 2009, 2008), Patients' Choice 5th Anniversary Award (2012), Compassionate Doctor Recognition (2018, 2017, 2015, 2014), and On-Time Doctor Award (2018).
