The Metaverse Arts Museum is offering virtual spaces for artists to display their work as <u>non-fungible</u> <u>tokens</u> (NFTs) on the blockchain. This allows for the creation of truly unique and verifiable digital art, which can be collected and traded like physical art.

In addition to showcasing NFT art, the museum will also host a variety of events and activities for the community, including workshops, <u>charity shops</u>, and exhibitions. It will serve as a hub for the growing NFT art scene, providing a space for creators and collectors to connect



and engage with each other. The Museum will also be supported by a host of celebrities that will feature in seasonal exhibits. There are dedicated floors in the Museum that will be leased out by the world's leading brands and patrons of the arts to display their work and products.

In collaboration with a UK-based fundraising partner, the Museum will be creating awareness for charitable causes for world-renowned charities through its innovative spaces. There are two levels of the museum dedicated to registered charities that have the opportunity to display their non-fungible tokens (NFTs). Proceeds from the sales of the NFTs are transferred directly to charities to support their campaigns and projects. The Museum attracts a large and engaged audience and provides an important and meaningful way for charities to make a positive impact on the world through the power of art and <u>crypto philanthropy</u>.

To help achieve this vision, the Museum has selected **Mr. Ashraf Ghori** as its **Arts Ambassador** (<u>https://www.ashrafghori.com</u>). Ghori is an award-winning Dubai-based artist whose pioneering, thoughtprovoking creations have received widespread acclaim. He aims to help to elevate the profile of the museum and the artists it represents, and further establish the region as a hub of artistic excellence.

"This is a truly innovative concept that will change the way we think about digital art and the role of museums in the digital age", said Ghori. "We realize that there is a wealth of emerging artistic talent in need of proper exposure, representation, and a platform to showcase their abilities, and the Metaverse Arts Museum will help bridge that gap."

The Metaverse Arts Museum launches on the Sandbox, an open-world gaming experience featuring Snoop Dogg, Paris Hilton, Gucci, and Tony Hawk among others.
