
Uthinkindigo Hosts A Clubhouse Event "Operation Ghana Arise" with Award-Winning Production Sound Mixer Willie D. Burton

As a member of the Minority Diversity Committee at Netflix and a board member of the Academy Awards and the Cinema Audio Society, he is dedicated to promoting diversity and inclusion in the film industry.

In his career Burton has worked with some of the best directors in the industry, including Steven Spielberg, Clint Eastwood, John Badham, Sam Mendes, the late Jonathan Demme, Ava Duvernay, F. Gary Gray, David Fincher and Denzel Washington to name a few. This has given him an opportunity to observe their techniques over the years, and ultimately develop his own style as a director. Burton's latest project is "Voices," a short film that addresses issues of racism, police brutality, Covid-19, and the Black Lives Matter movement, featuring actor Lamman Rucker. He is also developing several new projects, including a supernatural thriller and two documentaries.

The Clubhouse event will provide an opportunity for participants to engage in a conversation with Willie D. Burton, as well as to learn more about Uthinkindigo's mission and its campaign for global expansion.
