
Wilner Samson, MD, a Nephrologist with Hartford HealthCare Medical Group

Board-certified in both internal medicine and nephrology, the doctor is a Diplomate of the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Licensed to practice medicine in Connecticut, Dr. Samson is affiliated with medical facilities such as Midstate Medical Center, The Hospital of Central Connecticut at New Britain General Campus, and UConn John Dempsey Hospital.

Sharing an interest in professional affiliations, he is an active member of the American Association for Physician Leadership, the Renal Physicians Association, and the American Society of Nephrology.

Nephrology is a specialty of medicine and pediatrics that concerns itself with the kidneys: the study of normal kidney function and kidney disease, the preservation of kidney health, and the treatment of kidney disease, from diet and medication to renal replacement therapy. Nephrologists have advanced training in treating kidney disease. They diagnose and treat kidney failure, as well as help patients by prescribing medications, offering special diet advice, and coordinating dialysis care when the time comes.

Due to the fact that Dr. Samson is trilingual in English, Creole (Haitian), and French, patients from a variety of backgrounds enjoy having him as their physician.
