New York Kathak Festival 2023: Celebrating the Beauty and Diversity of Kathak Dance

Led by distinguished artists, the workshops, taught in the traditional *gurukul* style of learning, will provide participants with insights into the nuances and techniques of kathak, fostering a deeper understanding and appreciation of this ancient art form.

Pandit Rajendra Gangani, guru at Kathak Kendra, India's leading institute for kathak, is renowned for his technical mastery over rhythm and will be teaching workshops at the NYKF. Shri Prashant Shah, a vibrant New York based choreographer will also be leading workshops, and sharing his unique point of view around choreography. Vidushi Shama Bhate, a highly tenured and respected artist with 50 years of experience in kathak will lead a lecture demonstration on choreography. Participants will have the rare chance to hone their skills and learn directly from these distinguished artists.

"We are delighted to bring back the New York Kathak Festival, showcasing the richness and vibrancy of kathak dance," said the festival's organizers. "This year's festival promises to be an immersive experience, celebrating both tradition and innovation within kathak. We invite everyone, from dance enthusiasts to curious newcomers, to join us and witness the magic of kathak, the dance of the storyteller."
