Telemedicine is Facilitating Sick Leave and Sick Pay Policies, Which Is A Part of Employee Rights in Ireland

The Government of Ireland has implemented a variety of workplace policies and rules following the Work-Life Balance and Miscellaneous Provisions Act 2023. For instance, requesting the flexibility of remote work was not previously a legal right, but it is now. On the other hand, the statutory sick pay scheme (SSPS) has increased the prevalence and flexibility of paid sick leave policies across Irish industries.

Responsibility is necessary for flexibility. To be eligible for paid sick leave from work or permission to work from home due to illness, employees must submit a doctor's note on a sick note.

After the COVID pandemic, a lot of this rigidity has eased, even if workplaces and legal attitudes used to be more uncompromising about the authenticity of a medical certificate being established by physically visiting a doctor.

Online sick certificates are now more widely accepted in Ireland thanks to conscientious digital systems offered by telemedicine platforms like Get Sick Cert. This specifically gives employees time to unwind and makes it easier for them to maintain office decorum with less effort.

How an Online Sick Certificate Works for Employees in Ireland

What really works for Get Sick Cert is how they have designed the system and the dos and don'ts for employees to generate the online <u>sickness certificate in Ireland</u>.

• The Process of Obtaining a Medical Cert

All you have to do is visit the website of the medical cert provider, fill out a medical questionnaire form, and make your payment. Your application is assessed by an Irish-registered doctor, who reverts to you within 24 hours with their decision.

• Terms of Use of Online Medical Certificate

The defined processes used by these platforms often provide accurate assessment and recording. They might ask you for the relevant information, including your personal data and medical history, regarding your symptoms. It is because of legitimate criteria and a regulated environment that follow Irish state law and a legitimate system, that it gets widely accepted by employers.

- This sick certificate only proves that you were unfit to work due to a minor illness like a sore throat, mild fever, upset stomach, and so on. It cannot be used for fitness-to-work certification.
- The platform only works for issuing a medical certificate for an ongoing illness, it doesn't work when you have fully or partially recovered and are looking to backdate your illness at the last minute.

- The certificates only apply to private companies and do not apply to social welfare sick certificates such as the MC1 or MC2 forms.
- There is a time limit for generating online sick certificates. You cannot get more than one certificate within a period of 7days.
- The system only works for healthy individuals. It does not work for individuals who are diagnosed with chronic diseases like hypertension, diabetes, or neurological problems. For such conditions, it is important to see the doctor in person.

Employers are more likely to have faith in the system when candidates are instructed to follow a specific rule and full monitoring and verification procedures are in place. Thus, at a low cost, these telemedicine services benefit both employers and employees by saving them time and hassle.
