Roland-Garros stadium – known typically for the French Open – will be the site of Tennis and Boxing. On the Esplanade des Invalides, just a stone's throw from Napoleon's tomb, Archery will be held. And under the Luxor obelisk of the Place de la Concorde (between the Arc de Triomphe & Louvre art museum), several events will be competed for Olympic glory.

With a year left, there's still plenty of time to prepare - or is there?
