
Megan C. Turley, MD, MHS, a Colorectal Surgeon with Texas Colon & Rectal Specialists—Austin North

Colorectal surgeons specialize in the preoperative, operative, and postoperative care of patients with colorectal disorders. They have comprehensive knowledge about general surgery and the diagnosis and treatment of disorders of the rectum, anus, and colon.

Reflecting her dedication to providing the highest quality of care in the field of colon and rectal surgery, Dr. Turley has been recognized for her outstanding teaching skills with the Appleseed Teaching Award at Duke University for the academic years 2015-2016. She also received the Resident Achievement Award for the years 2017-2019.
