
Mystery of Neanderthals Drives Final Warning

New novel posits unique theory of disappearance

"My book is a sort of campy space opera with a serious purpose, similar to the movie 'Don't Look Up!' Or perhaps a Marx Brothers movie crossed with an old episode of 'Star Trek'," Drum says. "It's a wacky little comedy, for sure, but it does have a very serious purpose."

<u>Final Warning: Return of the Neanderthals</u> will be issued as a 284-page paperback priced at \$14.95, available from Amazon and other vendors. A companion Kindle e-book is in the works. Both the paperback and e-book will be released on Halloween, according to the publisher.
