An electrophysiologist is a type of cardiologist. They focus on the heart's timing or electrical system, and on diagnosing and treating irregular heartbeats or arrhythmias. They are also qualified to perform special tests of the heart's electrical system, such as an electrophysiology study or an ablation.

Dr. Gonzalez has received several accolades throughout his career, including the Carl T. Hayden Award for Excellence in Internal Medicine, the Allan Gregory Deem Award for Excellence in Cardiac Electrophysiology, and recognition as one of the Best Doctors of 2009 by El Paso Magazine.
