Board certified in both surgery and surgical critical care, the doctor is recognized as a Diplomate of the American Board of Surgery (ABS). The ABS is an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for the purpose of certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.

Holding academic appointments, Dr. Clancy serves as a Professor of Surgery at the University of South Florida, and as an Adjunct Clinical Associate Professor of Surgery at the Indiana University School of Medicine.

His professional network extends to membership status with the American Association for the Surgery of Trauma, the Eastern Association for the Surgery of Trauma, the Society of Critical Care Medicine, the American College of Surgeons (Fellow), the American College of Physician Executives, and the American College of Healthcare Executives.

Trauma surgery is a surgical specialty that utilizes both operative and non-operative management to treat traumatic injuries, typically in an acute setting. Trauma surgeons generally complete residency training in general surgery and often fellowship training in trauma or surgical critical care. They are responsible for treating bone fractures, cuts, internal injuries, burns, and shock. They also perform surgery to repair penetrating and blunt-force injuries.
