

## Ohio State Parks Foundation Announces Annual “Vote for Your Favorite State Park” Fundraiser

Donations and votes will be tallied through Monday, April 29. Each winning state park will retain a portion of the funds donated, which will go toward park improvement projects and focus on the Ohio State Park Foundation’s mission which is to enhance, preserve, and protect the parks.

Voters' names will be entered into a random drawing with a chance to win an official Ohio State Parks Passport book or a 2-night RV rental with RV Wholesalers (blackout dates may apply). Last year, Lake White and Hocking Hills were voted as the top favorite state parks.
