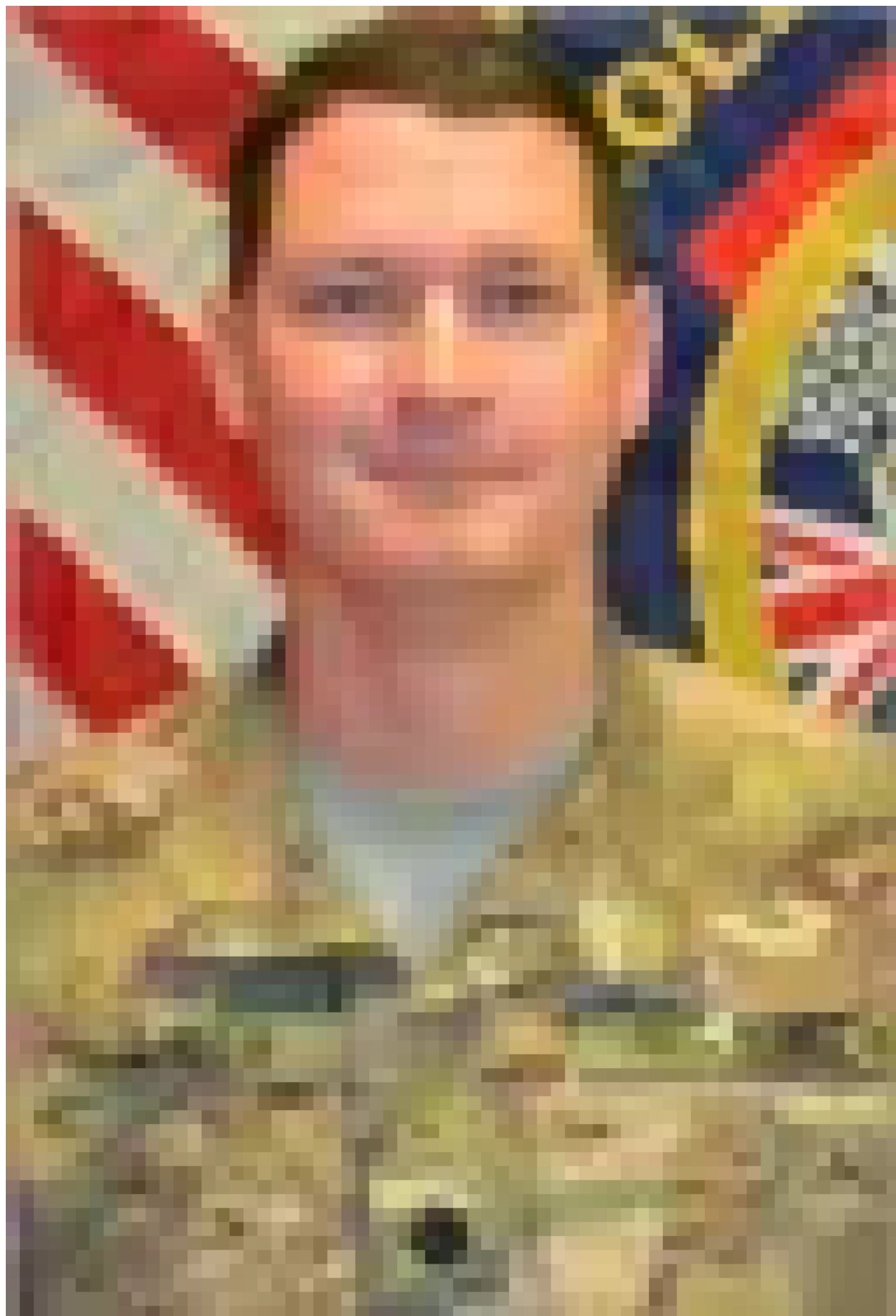


Capt. Jacob Glaser, USNR, Distinguished Trauma and Critical Care Surgeon at Madigan Army Medical Center
