
The 52nd Street Project says hello! to a new show in "LOOK WHO'S TALKING, Plays That Speak to You" from August 16 - 18

Audiences of all ages can expect to laugh out loud as pairs of adult actors and Project members take the stage across three performances to bring these hilariously *expressive* plays to life.
