Scoring original music for three of five powerful episodes in the acclaimed series

The three episodes scored by The Ring Music Group are titled Celestine Tate Harrington (1955-1998), Brad Lomax (1950-1984), and Thomas Wiggins (1849-1908). "Our goal with the score in the *RENEGADES* series was to capture the essence of these compelling stories, giving them a musical identity that reflects their spirit of rebellion and innovation. The Kennedy Center premiere is an esteemed platform to showcase this collaboration."

"If You Could See You" and "My Whole Heart" have both peaked at the top spot on the Billboard Adult R&B Airplay and Mediabase charts. The Ring Music Group rounded out 2023 by penning and producing several notable records for Philly-native and 300 Entertainment recording artist Kenya Vaun - "Summer," "Summer (Remix) feat.

Musiq Soulchild” and “Yesterday.” Of those records, “Summer” also spent a number of weeks in the Top 10 of the Billboard Adult R&B Airplay chart. At the heart of The Ring Music Group is the understanding that love is the essential fuel that propels their creative endeavors. This ethos is omnipresent in every project they undertake, seeing them apart from their peers through a deep and intentional focus on each record they produce.

About [RENEGADES](#) (PBS Film Series)

RENEGADES is a series of five 12-minute short films showcasing the lives of diverse, lesser-known historical figures with disabilities, exploring not only their impact on and contributions to U.S. society, but also the concept of disability culture, which honors the uniqueness of disability. Hosted and narrated by the musician and disability rights advocate Lachi, who is blind, and created and produced by a team of D/deaf and disabled filmmakers, the series is designed to increase public knowledge of disability history, and encourage cross-cultural understanding between non-disabled people and those with disabilities – who make up 1 in 4 adults in America today.
