
Hollywood Visionary Leland Yeshua DeWayne Returns to L.A. Ahead of the 67th Grammys

An avid admirer of Malibu's breathtaking coastline, DeWayne also expressed deep sorrow over the recent environmental devastation: "I cried when I [saw what happened in] Malibu." While he has long maintained a rental property along the beaches, he remained tight-lipped about its current status and exact location.

"I'm still actively [shaping] the creative [vision for] my artist roster at Universal, [driving] the evolution of new-age finance and media, and [working on initiatives that merge] fine arts [with] outer space through [collaborations] with NASA."

Whether the focus is love, business, or community, Leland Yeshua DeWayne remains a key figure in Hollywood's inner circles. Back in L.A., he is reconnecting with industry veterans, government officials, and emerging talent, while maintaining his ties to the influential networks that shape the entertainment world. With access to high-level deals and strategic partnerships, his time at home is expected to be filled with meaningful collaborations as he prepares for the year ahead.
