The book's principles are already transforming families and communities worldwide, helping parents reclaim their influence and inspire their children to become future leaders in business, education, and beyond.

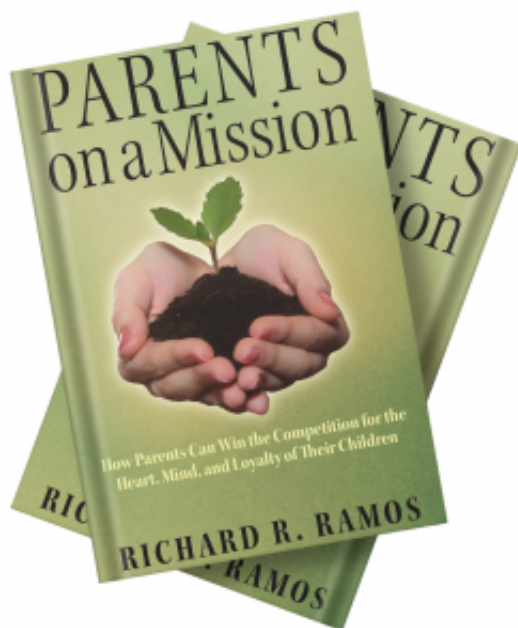
